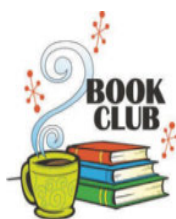
BELL CHOIR

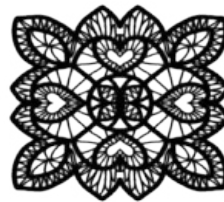
