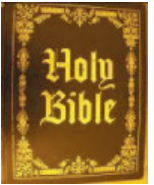

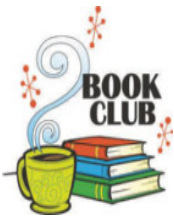

Classes for Olivedale members, all experience levels. Fee is **\$3/person** or **\$5/couple**. Join us

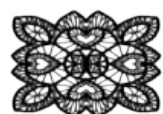
