Elevator Fail-safe System

Most elevators are equipped
with fail-safe systems
designed to bring the car to
the ground floor in the event
of a stoppage or power loss.
Our elevator uses gravity to
safely return the cab to the
bottom floor, where
passengers can easily exit and
emergency personnel can
access the car. If the elevator
stops during office hours,
please press the alarm button
and staff will quickly respond
and re-set. If after hours, exit
the cab and find an instructor
to re-set. If someone is
trapped or experiencing an
emergency in the elevator and
calls 911, it's important to wait
near the elevator for first
responders even if you've
safely exited. Sticking around
ensures responders don't
waste critical time thinking
someone is still inside.

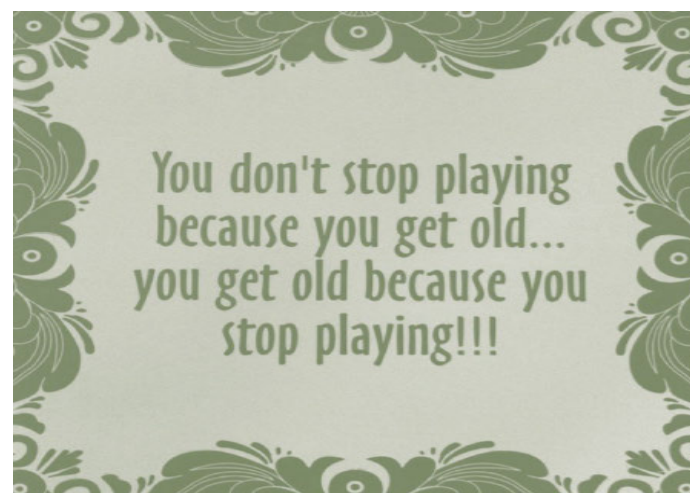
QUILT CHARMS


