New Year's Eve, Eve dance w/ Johnny Garber





CHANGES AHEAD FOR 2026 DAY TRIPS

We're so grateful for your continued enthusiasm for our day trips. They've become a highlight for many of us! We want to share updates regarding the future planning and organizing of day trips starting in 2026. The Challenge of Advance Planning: Imagine trying to book a popular venue months in advance without knowing how many people will join or having the funds to reserve. It is a bit like trying to guess how many seats to save at a dinner party before anyone RSVPs!

A big challenge with venues is advance reservations and deposits required often before our newsletter reaches you. This poses a significant challenge, of running the risk of covering the cost of unused tickets, which is not financially sustainable.

The Reality of Trip Costs:
We truly value your input!
We recently reviewed the feedback from the survey in our August newsletter. We heard loud and clear that most members would like to keep the cost of a day trip between \$80 and \$100.
While rising costs make it tough to keep trips under

\$100, we're committed to keeping them as affordable as possible and just as memorable.

Our New Approach for 2026: To address both the strict reservation deadlines and the rising costs in 2026: By offering fewer trips with more lead time, we're giving everyone a better chance to plan, save, and enjoy each outing to the fullest. 
