Maintenance Work



On June 17 Olivedale will welcome contractors to repaint and epoxy the upstairs restroom floors. Once the floors are complete, they will then install FRP (Fiber Reinforced Polymer) panels in both restrooms. Therefore, these **restrooms will be closed to our membership from Wednesday, June 17th - June 22nd**. The floor process will take several days and produce an odor. On Wednesday the 17th, the only restrooms available will be downstairs in the Health & Fitness area and the single restrooms in the hallway of the East Wing. Thursday, the 18th senior activities will be cancelled due to the smell from the epoxy but the Health & Fitness Center will remain open. Olivedale is closed Friday, June 19 for the holiday. Those individuals with

health issues or difficulties opening and closing doors may wish not to participate in activities on June 17 or Monday June 22. We're sorry for the inconvenience but the improvements will outweigh the disruption. The Olivedale Board approved this project to enhance the Olivedale Senior experience. 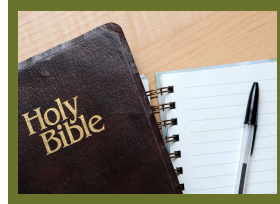

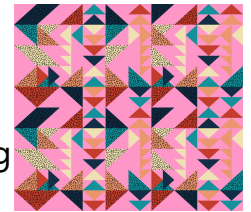
Line Dance

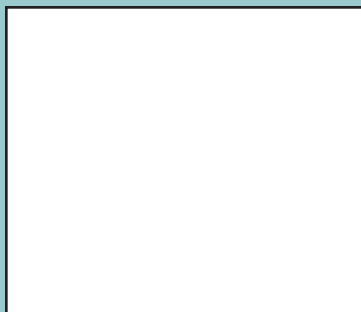

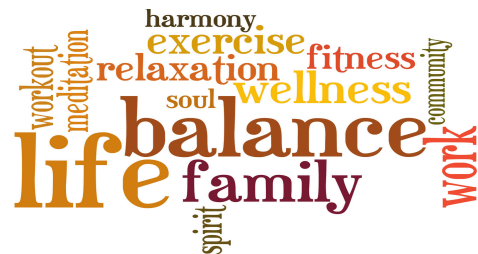

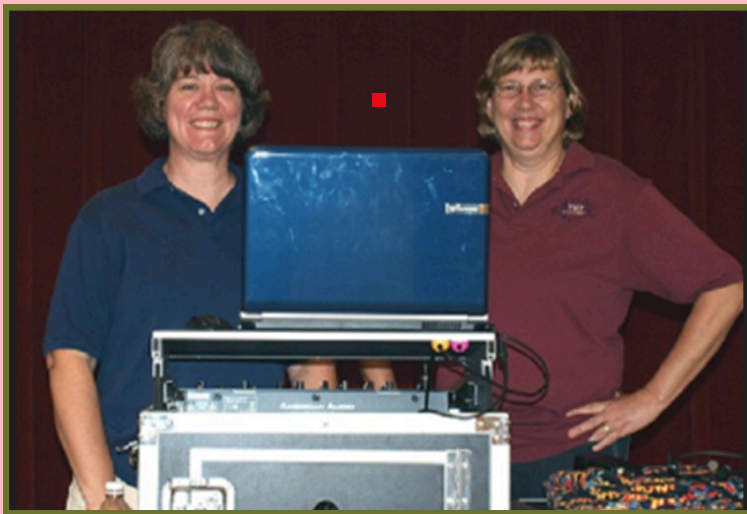
