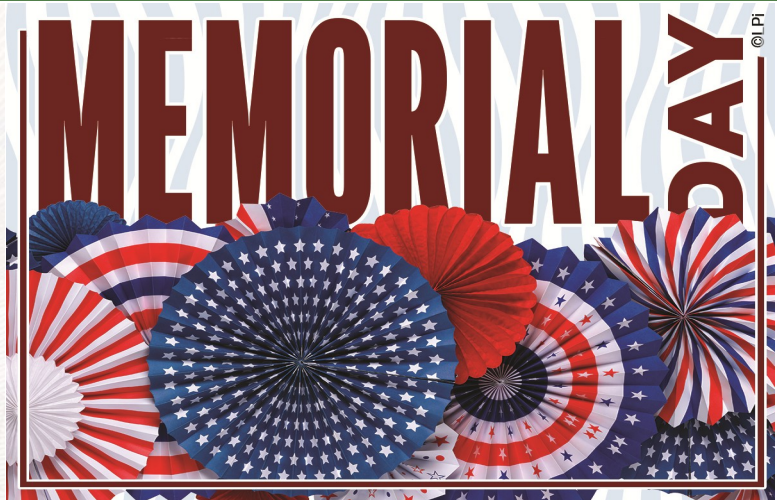

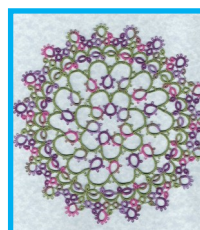
## Neuromovement® Class

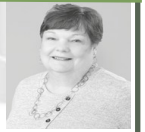
